Burnaby Recreation Credit Program Application for Canada-Ukraine Authorization Emergency Travel Applicants or Privately Sponsored Refugees

What is Recreation Credit?

The Recreation Credit program provides Burnaby residents in financial need, as confirmed by a recognized verifying agencies, a credit to be used at any Burnaby Parks, Recreation and Culture facility for programs and admissions. There are some exceptions such as golf, private lessons, and birthday parties. The Recreation Credit has no cash value and is valid for one year.

If you are low income or receiving government assistance, complete the Burnaby Recreation Credit program application.

You must meet the following criteria to apply:

- live in Burnaby (proof of address is required)
- be a Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) applicant OR
- be a Privately Sponsored Refugee
